### **2003 Chateau le Bouis Cuvee K (Corbieres, France)**

Winner of the 2005 Medaille 'Or. The le Bouis Cuvee K exhibits subtle new world elegance combined with French old vine depth. This wine is 100% Syrah, richly layered with blueberry and an assortment of wild dark berry flavors from Corbieres appellation in Languedoc. There are violets on the nose and extreme length through the finish. Hints of spice and haunting flavors emerge throughout. The common comment about this wine is "WOW, there is so much going on in the glass."

### **2001 Le Tre Stelle Ciliegiolo (Super Tuscan)**

We have a very rare 2003 Super Tuscan, Le Tre Stelle Ciliegiolo. The Le Tre Stelle is velvety and filled with distinct blackberry, blueberry and raspberry flavors. There are Asian and an aromatic spice prevalent in the finish, the Ciliegiolo has exceptional length. Though this wine will age at least five years, it is truly wonderful right now. The structure of the Ciliegiolo is round; enough for a big steak. The tannin is well infused and the berry so prevalent that it will pair beautifully with lamb, duck and pork. Make no mistake, this is a massive wine in the glass which will pair with the richest of sauces, yet the flavors are elegant enough for cheeses or chocolate.

### **2003 Tenuta de Luia (Super Tuscan)**

Luia is a top notch designer Super Tuscan. Luia is new to the American market. When reading the Parker notes he scored the 01 Luia 90 points and refers to the 03, in this offer, as "notably better". The Cab in it tastes as though it will improve for another 10 years. I would say that Luia rivals any Ornellaia or Sassacaia, but Luia is a style of its own. The Sangiovese is very smooth and blueberry, yet the Cab is almost Pichon Lalande, very granular and flavorful. Though Luia is massive in the glass, it is immediately drinkable when poured and becomes even bigger and silkier with air. We first inquired about Luia when the Italian Publication, Veronelli Articoli gave the Luia 3 stars and placed Luia in the top 100 Italian wines of 2003. Luia is one of the greatest Super Tuscans wines being produced today, there are less than 300 cases produced.

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## **2003 San Filippo Brunello di Montalcino (Tuscany)**

Made from the Sangiovese vine, which in Montalcino is known as Brunello. It is aged in oak for 2-3 ½ years. The final period of refinement up to the termination of the fifth year takes place in the bottle. This Brunello has blackberry, spice and meat follow through to a full-bodied palate, with lots of raisin, berry and earth character. Long and luscious, almost decadent 2,400 cases made.
